




FAMILIES WHO ARE STRUGGLING



There are more than 300,000 people in Utah living at, or below, the poverty line. This includes many children. Salt Lake City Mission helps our struggling neighbors from becoming homeless by helping them "make ends meet" by providing: food boxes, clothing, school supplies, furniture/household items, and other necessities. This greatly helps families with low incomes to stretch their budgets.

Our daily services and annual events assisted over 56,000 people locally in 2017. Meeting each one's greatest need. These include:

- Upward Motion Men's Program (Residential Recovery Program)
- Daily Chapel and Meal Services
- Women's Bible Study
- Day Center with shuttle service for the homeless
- Food Pantry
- Clothing Room
- Annual Back to School Giveaway
- Annual holiday banquets and food box giveaways
