27th Anniversary Milestones 1993 – 2019

Over 4.6 Million Meals Served – 5.6 Million articles of clothing distributed to the needy and over 573,846 lives impacted and changed.

Impact Results 2018 - 2019 Fiscal Year

- **Served over 245,684 prepared meals** and 24,580 food box and bag meals to the hungry and homeless, and families - locally - throughout our communities. This provided over 2,079,840 meals to those in great need.
- **Served Breakfast** – Monday – Friday in the Wigand Center Court Yard, from our portable kitchen unit, and lunch at the mission facilities serving 3,076 meals a week, over 105,532 meals a month and over 159,820 a year.
- **Held special outreach meal events** on Easter Sunday, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day. Hosted annual events to include: Back to School Giveaway, Mother’s Day Event for homeless mothers, while serving over 16,900 hot prepared meals at these events.
- **Cared for over 54,687 people** with assistance, food, help, counseling, hygiene items, education, opportunities, etc. and over 639,548 pieces of clothing, household goods, furniture, appliances and misc. distributed to the neediest of our community and gave out over 12,000

pairs of brand-new shoes donated by Kuru® Footwear this year.

- **Received support from over 6,225 Volunteers** that performed over 50,849 hours of service to the needy and destitute throughout the year.
- **Witnessed to over 5,000 people** as they made faith decisions for Jesus Christ.
- **Distributed over 306 holiday baskets** that fed over 2,448 Thanksgiving meals to destitute families.
- **Catered a Thanksgiving dinner** to over 3,350 needy individuals at the Vivint Arena during the Thanksgiving season.
- **On Thanksgiving Day** served Thanksgiving dinner to over 3,450 at “The Christian Life Center”
- **Supplied over 200 households** with Christmas boxes, including turkey’s, ham’s, trimmings & toys with eagle ranch.
- **On Christmas day, served over 3,600 Christmas dinners**, and gave out over 4,500 wrapped Christmas presents to needy and homeless men, women, and children.
- **On New Year’s Day served over 3,200 New Year’s meals** to the poor, with the help of over 200 volunteers assisting.
- **Conducted more than 4,106 counseling sessions** to needy souls.
- **Paid co-pays** for hearing aids, eyeglasses and prescription medication for our clients.
- **Facilitated GED’s, Vocational Rehabilitation assistance** and college for homeless people and men in our Recovery Programs.
- **Through “Salt Lake City Street News,”** created over 180 active self-employment opportunities for the homeless.
- **Conducted over 25,000 hours of Bible Studies, Life Skills Classes, Group Sessions & Counseling Sessions.**
- **Graduated 10 men** from our Phase I, II and III Long-Term Recovery Programs.
