MESSAGE from the Co-Director of Salt Lake City Mission Joe Vazquez

We have been quite busy since our last newsletter!

We continue to be open and covid free. PRAISE GOD! Something that was totally unexpected just happened, of which I am completely humbled by... and in awe of God. At this unique moment I feel we were on the right track in our organizational efforts during the last year...

I was recognized by the Federation of Mexicans United in Utah for my leadership in the Covid Pandemic, not only for organizing our efforts in providing relief for many Utahans (over 157,000 assisted), but also for our efforts to communicate to and assist the Hispanic community throughout northern Utah during the covid crisis.

Along with all of our regular English

language communications Salt Lake City Mission implemented our first ever campaign working with Spanish television (Telemundo) and Spanish radio (La Ley and Mi Preferida) with messaging communicating covid protection, locations for assistance, and provision of additional outreach sites in seven Utah counties potentially reaching well over 450,000 Spanish speaking people.

This same award was given to Salt Lake County Mayor, Jenny Wilson, Utah State Senator, Luz Escamilla, and the CEO of Globus Relief, Ash Robinson. It was an awesome privilege to be appreciated for our work during the pandemic alongside noted government officials, and the CEO of a great company providing global assistance to literally hundreds of thousands of people in need.



