## ***30th ANNIVERSARY MILESTONES 1993 - 2022***

***Over 6.29 Million Meals Provided – 6.64 Million Articles of Clothing Distributed to the Needy and Over 691,383 Lives Impacted and Changed***

Established in 1986 as the Spectacular Ministries of the Lords' Servants to minister to the incarcerated and disfranchised in the Utah State Prison, and then in 1993 the Salt Lake City Mission was established to help the homeless disenfranchised and poor become independent, productive members of society through a life centered in Jesus Christ.

Salt Lake City Mission staff, management and board are committed to helping all people who have a genuine need and depravation, regardless of race, creed, religion, age, or national origin. Salt Lake City Mission provides emergency services and long-term recovery programs; we help meet the physical, mental, educational, and spiritual needs of families, children and individuals.

### **Impact Results 2021 - 2022 Fiscal Year**

*During this past year, Salt Lake City Mission has provided blessings to the community as follows:*

- Watched over 2,950 people make faith decisions for Jesus Christ.
- Provided over 364,685 meals in 59,682 boxes and meal-bags to the destitute and needy of Utah throughout this year.
- Held special "Outreaches" starting with Harvest for the Hungry in October. Salt Lake City Mission held events for Thanksgiving, Christmas, Easter, International Day of Women, Memorial Day, 4th of July, and Labor Day. The Salt Lake City Mission also hosted Mardi Bra.
- Provided 250 gift bags to mothers on Mother's Day and another 170 gift bags to fathers for Father's Day.
- Provided 1,365 backpacks with supplies at the Back-to-School Giveaway.
- Distributed over 600 Turkey Baskets that fed over 3,600 souls providing Thanksgiving meals to destitute families in dire need.
- Partnered with Utah Jazz, and Centerplate, to provide over 3,750 individuals with a traditional Thanksgiving Meal.
- Supplied over 2,700 Households with Christmas Holiday Food Boxes.
- Provided over 2,300 "Delicious" Christmas Meals.
- Cared for over 161,000 people with assistance, food, help, counseling, hygiene items, education, opportunities, and over 360,000 pieces of clothing, household goods, furniture, and appliances.
- Conducted more than 3,000 counseling sessions to needy souls.
- Paid \$2,690 in co-pays for hearing aids, eyeglasses and prescription medication direct assistance for our clients.
- Facilitated GED's, Vocational Rehabilitation assistance and college for homeless people and men in our Recovery Programs.
- Conducted over 19,950 hours of Bible Studies, Life Skills Classes, Group Sessions & Counseling Sessions
- Received encouragement and support from over 7,500 Volunteers that performed over 20,950 hours of service.
